*This programme demands commitment, discipline, and consistent effort. Students who fail to comply with all rules and regulations will be removed from the programme and **WILL NOT** be promoted to Grade 13.*

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Successful applicants to Grade 12 MUST have:

- **Five (5) or more** subjects at the CSEC General Proficiency Level.
- A pass in **CSEC English Language** and **Mathematics** **OR** City & Guilds Stage 3 with **distinction** in **English Language** and **Mathematics**.
- **Grade 1** or **2** in the subjects they wish to pursue in Grade 12.

NON-ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- Good conduct
- Minimum 80% attendance in Grade 11
- Participation in at least one extra-curricular activity
- Completed 72 hours of Community Service (**This applies ONLY to OHHS students who did PATHWAY 2 in the previous academic year**).

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

1. Submit the completed application form and the **non-refundable processing fee receipt of \$3,000** to the Sixth Form Coordinators on **Wednesday, August 19 & Thursday, August 20, 2026, between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. at the Lecture Theatre**
2. Results (accepted applicants and shortlisted candidates for interview) will be posted on the school's notice board on **Thursday, August 27, 2026 @ 5:00 P.M.**
3. Interviews will be conducted on **Monday, August 31, 2026 @ 9:00 A.M.** Interviews provide career guidance and assist with subject selection.
4. Interview results will be posted on the school's notice board on **Wednesday, September 2, 2026, on the school's notice board @ 5: 00 P.M.**

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Two (2) recent recommendations (no older than 6 months). **(Transfer students only).**
- Two (2) recent passport-sized photographs. **(No Hair Extensions)**
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of CSEC results
- Copies of the last **TWO** (2) school reports. **Required for all applicants. Do not submit original documents.**
- **Transfer Forms** (available for purchase at the Principal's Office or online) **must be completed by all non-OHHS students applying to the school.** It must be signed and stamped by the principal or vice principal of the previous school and submitted with this application.
- A Driver's Education Programme (practical and theory) is available through IVPT in partnership with OHHS. Participating students **MUST** pay all fees.
